Assistant Sheriff Jerry Gutierrez has been a member of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department since 1990. He has nearly 28 years of experience in Riverside County Jail Operations. He began his career as a Correctional Deputy and worked a variety of assignments while assigned to the Robert Presley Detention Center, and later, the Ben Clark Training Center.



In 1998, he was promoted to the rank of Correctional Sergeant and remained at the Ben Clark Training Center and was later assigned to the Southwest Detention Center. In 2003, he was promoted to the rank of Correctional Lieutenant. As a Correctional Lieutenant, he served at the Southwest Detention Center and the Robert Presley Detention Center.

In 2008, he was promoted to the rank of Correctional Captain and was assigned to the Sheriff's Department's Planning and Research Unit. He was then later assigned to the Southwest Detention Center as the facility commander in 2009.

In 2010, he was appointed to the rank of Correctional Chief Deputy and assigned to Sheriff's Administration. As a Chief Deputy, he was responsible for both Corrections Operations and Support Divisions.

In November 2014, Sheriff Stan Sniff appointed Assistant Sheriff Gutierrez to his current rank. In this capacity, he oversees the Corrections Divisions.
